# "MAPS – Royal Thai Government Scholarships" Academic Year 2019/20

Master of Arts in Asia-Pacific Studies (MAPS), Thammasat University is now accepting applications for scholarships for the academic year 2019/20. A number scholarships are offered to nations of five ASEAN member countries namely the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, the Republic of Indonesia, and the Republic of Philippines to study the full-time Master of Arts in Asia-Pacific Studies Program at Thammasat University, Rangsit Center.

The awards are supported by Master of Arts in Asia-Pacific Studies (MAPS), Thámmasat University and the Thailand International Development Cooperation Agency (TICA), Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The awards aim to provide opportunity for students of these ASEAN countries to study in the international cultural environment as well as promoting the spirit of cooperation among students in ASEAN community. Each scholarship award includes

- 1. Tultion and fee throughout the period of the scholarship award
- 2. Accommodation/ Monthly allowance
- 3. Health insurance
- 4. A round-trip air ticket from the home country to Thalland on award of the scholarship

The scholarship recipients are expected to complete the MA degree within 18 months, to return and assist in the development of their home countries. They cannot obtain employment (full-time or part-time) or participate in internships during the period of study. Due to third country visit restrictions of certain countries, the scholarship recipients will not be offered the opportunity for the international student exchange programs.

# MASTER OF ARTS IN ASIA-PACIFIC STUDIES (International Program)

Master of Arts in Asia-Pacific Studies (MAPS) is an interdisciplinary graduate program that is designed for internationally – focused students who wish to obtain an in-depth understanding of this fascinating and occasionally turbulent part of the world through multi-faceted and inter-disciplinary lenses.

#### Core Focus

Thammasat Institute of Area Studies (TIARA) at Thammasat University offers a course-based master's degree program that structured around three core subjects: international economics, international relations and politics, and international laws and applying them to a myriad of situations in the Asia-Pacific Region.

#### **Program Details and Structure**

The full-time master's degree program is designed for students to complete in 18 months (three semesters and one summer semester session). Students are required the completion of 39 credits comprising of 27 credit course work component and 12 credit research component. Students are also to take part in the Post-graduate international Conference organizing by TIARA at Thammasat University.

#### Program Structure

Students are required to complete six core courses. These core courses provide a foundational understanding of the Asia-Pacific region. This core group consists of five required courses and one elective. While the required courses are compulsory, the elective course allows students the choice of either one module in contemporary area studies or public policy.

- Core Courses: General Education in International Economics, International Relations, International Law, and Asia-Pacific Studies
  - APSGOD Foundation Asia-Pacific Studies
- Core Course: International Economics Field
  - APS611 Economic Integration in the Asia-Pacific Region
  - APS612 Dynamism of Thai Economy
- Core Course: International Relations Field
  - APS621 Political, Security, and Defense Strategies in the Asia-Pacific Region
- Core Course: International Law Field
  - APS631 International Law and Regional Architecture
- Core Courses: Research Methodology
  - APS681 Research Methodology
- Elective Core Courses:
  - APS641 Contemporary Issues in Asia-Pacific Or
  - APS647 Public Policy Studies

#### **Scholarships**

MAPS Program is endorsed with the scholarship from various organizations. Our main sponsors for international students include Thailand International Cooperation Agency (TiCA), Thammasat University, PTT Public Company Limited, The Government Savings Bank, and EXIM Bank. A number of scholarships are offered on merit-based basis. Terms and Conditions may apply.

#### **Target Group:**

ASEAN nationals with a focus on CLMV countries

#### Eligibility:

- 1. A Bachelor's Degree in any field with a cumulative GPA of 3,0 and above from an accredited university
- 2. Minimum requirement of English Proficiency is 6.5 IELTS (IELTS 6.0 is acceptable see NOTE), 550 for paper-based TOEFL test, 79 for internet-based TOEFL test, and 213 for computer-based TOEFL test or 550 for TU-GET. The official score report of English Proficiency is valid only if the test was taken no more than 2 years prior to the last date of the application submission period. However, requirement for English Proficiency does not applied to native English speakers.
- 3. Students with an international Bachelor's Degree Program are not required to submit official evidence of English Proficiency test score upon application submission.
- 4. 4th year students who expect to graduate in the 2nd semester may apply for admission by submitting a Certified Letter of Expected Date of Graduation.
- 5. A statement of purpose and/or academic essay of approximately 500 words

Note: Thammasat University requires all students who are not native speakers to meet the minimum score of English Proficiency as a graduate requirement; therefore, students who have not met minimum requirement or have not yet submitted English Proficiency test score are required to submit official report of English proficiency to the University upon graduation.

#### **Application Instructions:**

- Admission and Scholarships are awarded based upon various criteria-overall academic performance, letters of recommendation, statement of purpose, academic essay, and the interview screening.
- 2. Please note that our scholarships are allocated on first-come-first-serve basis. It cannot be guaranteed that you will get the scholarship even you submitted your application and documents before our advertised deadline due to high competition. This, it is strongly advised to submit your complete application as soon as possible.
